

Welcome to New Zealand. Here are your car keys!



Upon arrival in Auckland Airport proceed to clear customs and immigrations.

Transfer to your hotel with super shuttle.

(Standard Check in time at Hotel is 14:00 Hrs. However early check in depending on the Hotel Availability) Rest of the day is at leisure.



16th November AUCKLAND - COROMANDEL (168kms/3hrs approx.)

This morning after having your delicious breakfast at hotel, proceed for Auckland city tour.

Visit Harbour Bridge, Viaduct Waterfront, Tamaki Drive, Savage Point, Parnell Rose Park and Village, Auckland Domain and Gardens etc. Visit Sky Tower, the biggest Tower in Southern Hemisphere at 328 mtrs. Proceed to the observation Deck to get the full city view of Auckland. Later, pickup your rental car and take scenic drive to Coromandel.

17th November
COROMANDEL - WAITOMO
(219kms/3hrs approx.)

After having your breakfast, proceed to Hahei Beach, a Hot Water Beach where you can dig your own spa. Later a small walk leads you to Cathedral cove, where a naturally formed archway deserves photographic attention.

17th November WAITOMO - ROTORUA (139kms/2hrs approx.)

Drive towards Waitomo Take a guided tour through the famous Waitomo Glowworm Caves. Over 45 minutes you'll see amazing stalactites, stalagmites, huge caverns and other limestone rock formations, formed over 30 million years ago. Your tour finishes with a magical boat ride through the Glowworm Grotto – a cavern illuminated by the twinkling lights of thousands of tiny glowworms. And later proceed to Rotorua.

The Coromandel is one of New Zealand's best-loved holiday destinations. The rugged volcanic hills are cloaked in native rainforest, and more than 400 kilometres of spectacular coastline promises you can find the beach of your dreams.



18th November ROTORUA

Post breakfast, proceed for Rotorua sightseeing. Visit
Agrodome farm show where you can see 19 different types of
sheep and enjoy the interactive show & later also visit to Te
puia for a guided tour of its bubbling mud pools and powerful
geyser.

Spend the evening relaxing at Polynesian spa.

19th November ROTORUA – WELLINGTON

(453kms/6hrs approx.)

proceed to Wellington, the coolest capital of the world via Taupo. En-route, visit Wai-o-tapu an active geothermal area at the southern end of the Okataina Volcanic Centre, just north of the Reporoa caldera. It is one of the most colorful and unique geothermal regions of New Zealand. Visit Hukka falls on the way.

20th NovemberWELLINGTON - NELSON


check-out from hotel & take ferry to Picton. Later, proceed to Nelson via Charollet drive.

(350 Kms/5 Hrs approx.)


Check-out from hotel & drive to Queenstown via Wanaka, visit Puzzling world & continue your journey to Queenstown.



Terms & Conditions

Booking:

Your contract is with Jigsaw Travels Private Limited A contract exists between us when we have confirmed you on our tour / hotel booking / or any other travel related services of your choice and we have received your booking request and deposits. All correspondence/s in respect of Tours / Travel Service bookings should be addressed to M/s. Jigsaw Travels Private Limited

Payments:

For the services contracted, 50% payment should be made to hold the booking on a confirmed basis and the balance amount should be paid 30 days before the commencement of your tour. We hold the right to decide upon the amount to be paid as an advance payment, based on the nature of services and the time left for the commencement of the services. Apart from the above in some cases like special packages, hotel or resort bookings during the high peak tourist season (X-Mas, New Year) full payment is required to be sent in advance.

Payment Options:

Payment can be made by Bank Transfer, Cash payment, Demand draft and credit/debit card at our offices. All payments should be free and clear of any withholding tax and deduction. Bank charges, if any, for remittance (by remitting bank or by intermediary bank) would be strictly borne by payer.

Rights to amend the itinerary if required:

Tour once commenced will strictly go as per the itinerary finalized. In case of events and circumstances beyond our control, we reserve the right to change all or parts of the contents of the itinerary for safety and well being of our esteemed passengers.

Policy Regarding Cancellation / No Show / Early Departure:

In case of cancellation of tour/travel services due to any avoidable/unavoidable reason/s we must be informed by email and phone notification. Cancellation charges would be effective from the date we receive the mail and cancellation charges would be as follows:

60 days prior to arrival - 30% of the advance deposited 45 days prior to arrival - 50% of the advance deposited 30 days and less or no show - NO REFUND

Please note - Irrespective of above mentioned cancellations slabs - in case of cancellation of tour services after the booking is made with us - a minimum 10% service charges would be applicable.

In case of booking during high peak season (Special seasons like Diwali - 15th Oct to 15th Nov - & X' Mas / New Year period - 15th Dec to 15th Jan) NO refund will be provided irrespective of the period.

In case you cancel the trip after commencement refund would be restricted to a limited amount that too would depend on the amount that we would be able to recover from the hoteliers we patronize. For unused hotel accommodation, chartered transportation and missed meals etc. we do not bear any responsibility to refund.

Refund:

In regard to refund of unused / unutilized services (which are paid for and cancelled in advance) the refund amount would be worked out on the basis of cancellation policy as described above and the money would be accordingly refunded to the person who has made the payment to us. Please note that the refund process may take 2 - 4 weeks due to banking procedures. If the refund is made to the credit card account or to Bank account, the bank charges would be debited from the refund amount.

Our Liabilities & Limitations:

Please note that after the finalization of the tour/service cost, if there are any hikes in entrance fees of monuments/museums, taxes, fuel cost or guide charges by the Govt. of India, the same would be charged as extra.

License: All drivers must be 25 years old or over and hold a valid Indian driver's license in English. If the customer presents an international driver's permit, this must be accompanied with their home country licence.
